





**Corvina Base of the United States Submarine Veterans, Inc.  
BYLAWS Attachment: Article XIV - Standing Rule No. 1**

The engraving of names on the USS Corvina (SS-226) Memorial pedestal located at the Northern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery, Fernley NV, upon departing on Eternal Patrol (EP), will be in accordance with the following rules:

1. Only Regular and Associate Members in good standing of the USSVI **and** the Corvina Base prior to departing on Eternal Patrol.
2. The members must have been qualified on US Navy Submarines, **or** assigned as a crew member on a US Navy Submarine.
3. If necessary, names should be engraved at least yearly, and completed prior to the annual September Base Memorial Service. Include the Name, Rank or Rating and Rate, maintaining the same font, depth of cut, spacing and centering as the names currently on the pedestal. The Base will be responsible for the cost of engraving.
